Tires and Wheels	Tire pressure. Wear on tires. Lug Bolts tight. (120 ft.lbs.) Axle Bolts tight. (150 ft.lbs) Grease caps on hubs.			
Brakes	Brake Fluid-DOT 3 (fill to 3/8 inch below top. Leaks on any joints or hoses. Actuator cable in place.			
Safety Chains and Hitch	Proper operation and wear.			
Tongue Jack	Proper function.			
Rear Stabilizing Jack	Operates.			
Lights	Proper operation. Wear or breaks on any wiring. Wiring secured.			
Lid Gas Springs	Lifts lid evenly, easily.			
Lid Rope and Handles	In place.			
Reflective Tape & labels	In place and visible			
Bins, door, lids.	In place and functional.			
Spare Tire mount, Tire. (If present.)	Mount secure, Tire pressure, wear.			
License Plate	Secure, present.			
Registration, Insurance.	Both present in holder.
