Director’s Report of October Activities:

- Bob Verkuilen, KNB President, made an office visit. Tree planting will take place in the spring using the KNB UPS shared tree grant.
- Dana attended the Nebraska Recycling Council fall virtual conference and several virtual and in-person workshops.
- Linda attended the Interagency mtg. in Plattsmouth & KNB virtual affiliate mtg.
- Planned KCCB Pumpkin Recycling Event at Plattsmouth Hy-Vee on Nov. 2 from 3:00 – 6:00 p.m. Carved pumpkins will be taken to Soil Dynamics for composting; uncarved will feed animals at the Wildlife Safari Park.
- KCCB fall newsletter was distributed via Cassgram attachment and personal emails.
- Held electronic recycling event at Louisville – approx. 48 households participated; collected 1,922 lbs. including 31 TVs/CRTs, several large appliances and 35 lbs. of batteries
- Loft Theater “Together Project” recognized KCCB board at Oct.16 show. Two new recycling bins were presented to manager Kevin Colbert to start recycling at the theater.
- Roger and Linda represented KCCB at the Weeping Water Sunset Banquet and donated a door prize.
- Dana provided fall recycling programs at Plattsmouth after School program for 25 MS youth, Conestoga Elem. School for 400 students, Plattsmouth St. John the Baptist Catholic School for 145 youth and 15 Murray Girl Scouts.
- Linda presented an Appreciation Award at an assembly to Marla Smith, Plattsmouth Middle School teacher, for her role in starting a water bottle recycling program last year.
- Provided recommendations for resources for Eagle’s return of a recycling program.
- Provided litter cleanup supplies for several groups: Plattsmouth Lions Club, Village of Manley, Town and Country Humane Society & Elmwood-Murdock FBLA organization
- Distributed recycling and litter prevention information at the Beaver Lake Trunk or Treat event for about 70 households and treats to about 125 youth.
- NDEE Qrt. 3 grant reimbursement reports were submitted for the cleanup grant, waste grant and public education grant.
